

#### **BOARD HIGHLIGHTS**

At the December 12 meeting the Board:

- Heard from Buildings and Grounds about repairs needed at Judd House
- Voted to upgrade the electrical system in the church kitchen and install a vent.
- Discussed repairing or replacing the vacuum cleaner in the church
- Heard an update on progress on refurbishing Drew House so it can be rented again
- Authorized Buildings and Grounds to contract for snow removal
- Voted to continue as fiscal sponsor for MUUSAN through June 2025
- Voted to establish the housing allowance for the minister at \$42,785.
- Voted to give the church administrator access to the Board's shared drive
- Discussed the final items to be funded by the safety grant
- Discussed the possibility of acquiring a defibrillator
- Decided not to apply for another safety grant
- Plan to put the alarm system on a timer
